

Anglican Men's Society

1905 –

Details

The Anglican Men's Society is a brotherhood of Clergy and Laymen representing the men of the Anglican church. It was formed in Queensland in 1905. The three Anglican Dioceses of Queensland, Brisbane, Rockhampton and North Queensland provide the opportunity for men to become Diocesan members.

According to a publication from 2003, Morris House, a Home in Taringa for young men aged over 15, was "operated by the Anglican Society of St Francis and Anglican Church Men's Society" (Boyce, For the Record, p.29). The publication does not provide details of how the two organisations ran Morris House together.
