This series contains two photo albums, as well as an assortment of loose photographs, showing people, buildings, and activities at Aboriginal settlements and Missions in Queensland, including Doomadgee, Cherbourg, Bamaga, Yarrabah, and Hope Vale. They include a photograph of approximately 80 children from the Doomadgee Mission dormitories. Some individuals who appear in these photographs have been identified by name. The photographs from Doomadgee date from 1940, the remainder of the photographs date from approximately 1950 to 1960.
