These include minutes, correspondence, photographs and other documents that may include information relating to the Woodville Spastic Centre and its predecessors, Dew Street Cottage, Albara Road Cottage and any other facilities run by SCOSA and SASPWA. A finding aid is available.

Access Conditions
