M135 Hagley Area Farm School contains correspondence between the Tasmanian Government Tourist and Immigration Department and the School. It includes the names of child migrants.

The correspondence includes:

- Queries about which boys are still at the School.
- Individual boys, for instance, about reunification with their parents.
- Maintenance payments from the Fairbridge Society.
- Child Welfare Officers' reports on the progress of individual boys.
- A newspaper clipping concerning the arrival of two Scottish boys.
- A request to Hagley to accept girls in order to boost the School's child migrant numbers.
- The acceptable age range of the new child migrants, which was 8 to 13.
- Progress with building a child migrant cottage.
