Norseman Mission view

Description: Norseman Mission, view' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the 1960s and was taken from the schoolhouse. In the foreground is superintendent's house; the red roofed dining room is to the left; and the building with the silver roof behind the dining room is the workshop, which held the lighting plant and other maintenance equipment. A number of the Homes for children are visible, and the tennis court is on the far right of the picture.



Bamburra exterior

Description: Bamburra exterior' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the 1970s.



Carnarvon Mission from the air

Description: Carnarvon Mission from the air is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the 1960s. The dining room is on the left of the photograph, with the U-shaped 'Kindergarten' in front. The kindergarten was the babies' and young children's dormitory



Carnarvon Mission children and sign

Description: Carnarvon Mission children and sign' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the early 1960s.



Wollaston

Description: Wollaston is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. Historian Deslee Moyle confirms that the image was taken in the early 1980s.



Fairhaven Hostel 1965

Description: 'Fairhaven Hostel 1965' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from 1965 and shows Fairhaven Hostel as it was when it was first purchased by the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board.



Carinya scatter cottage

Description: 'Carinya scatter cottage' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from 1980 or 1981 and shows one of the 'scatter cottages' in the Carnarvon township that were part of Ingada Village (which was the new name given to the Carnarvon Mission in 1975).



Mission School

Description: 'Mission School' is a digital copy of an image from the Carnarvon Mission, held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image shows the original mission school, probably around 1948.



Teens Hostel

Description: 'Teens Hostel' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the late 1960s. The hostel was established in 1968 as part of the Carnarvon Mission. The image shows the hostel (which was also called the 'Town Hostel') on the left, with the Christian Centre's hall in the middle and the church on the right.



Bethany kindergarten dormitory, Norseman Mission

Description: 'Bethany kindergarten dormitory, Norseman Mission' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the 1950s and shows the 'kindergarten' dormitory for little children, which was known as 'Bethany'.



Roelands Village, sign

Description: 'Roelands Village, sign' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from 1978 and shows the sign into Roelands Village, with the Village itself in the background.



Roelands Village, view

Description: 'Roelands Village, view' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from 1978 and shows the blue dining room on the right and the church in the middle. At the back, in the centre of the photograph in front of the hill, is the schoolhouse that had been used during when the property held the Roelands Native Mission Farm.



Roelands Campsite, Busselton

Description: 'Roelands Campsite, Busselton' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from 1983 and shows the campsite that was part of Roelands, on Caves Road between Busselton and Dunsborough. Camps were held on weekends and during school holidays for children who couldn't go home to family. Eventually, the campsite was released by the Shire Council to a local Aboriginal consortium.



Oval and playground, Carnarvon Mission

Description: Oval and playground, Carnarvon Mission' is a digital copy of an image held by Global Mission Partners in the Churches of Christ Federal Aborigines Mission Board Photographs collection. As described by historian Deslee Moyle, the image dates from the early 1980s
