Port Keats Mission Station is a correspondence file kept by the Office of the Administrator of the Northern Territory. It contains letters, memorandums and reports related to the mission at Port Keats. The file mainly includes correspondence between the Roman Catholic Church, the mission, and the Northern Territory administration. The file begins with correspondence about the establishment of the mission at Port Keats. It also contains applications from the mission for a government subsidy.
